QQI Certificate Courses

Special Needs Assisting, QQI Level 5, 5N1786 10 wks. | €350

Wed. & 3 Saturdays 21st Sep. to 30th Nov. 2016 Fee code - ESN5A

Explores the practices and principles underpinning the role of a Special Needs Assistant. Participants will be required to undertake practical work, complete a reflective diary and carry out a skills demonstration to assess the participant's ability to dress, feed and care for a child with disabilities.

Child Development & Play, QQI Level 4, 4N1111 10 wks. | €250

Wed. & 2 Saturdays 21st Sep. to 30th Nov. 2016 Fee code - ECD4A

Course prepares participants for work in Childcare. It looks at the key stages in child development (children 0 - 6 yrs.), including the child's physical, cognitive, linguistic, emotional, social and behavioural development. It also examines the importance of play on the child's well-being.

Irish in Everyday Use, QQI Level 4, 4N1179 10 wks. | €250

Wed. & 2 Saturdays 21st Sep. to 30th Nov. 2016 Fee code - EIE4A

Designed for those seeking to raise their proficiency in Irish. The emphasis is on improving the participant's skills through listening, speaking, reading and writing. A pass in Irish at QQI Level 3, Junior Certificate Level Irish or an equivalent award is necessary for entry.

Drawing, QQI Level 5, 5N1862 10 wks. | €320

Wed. & 2 Saturdays
9th Nov. to 7th Dec. 2016 & 1st Feb. to 8th Mar. 2017 Fee code - EDR5A

To develop drawing techniques and extend participant's awareness and skills in a range of drawing media. This course would be of interest to students seeking to prepare a portfolio relevant to further education in the visual arts.

Hobby/Leisure Courses

Pottery 10 wks. | €160

Wednesdays 21st Sep. to 30th Nov. 2016 Fee code - EPOTA

Covers the basic methods/techniques in pottery including, pinch pots, coil pots, slab building, mould making, pot throwing, 3D ceramic, relief sculpture and glazing. Participants will have the opportunity to make pottery with both functional and decorative applications.

Glass Fusing/ Slumping 10 wks. | €160

Wednesdays
9th Nov. to 7th Dec. 2016 & 1st Feb. to 8th Mar. 2017 Fee code - EGLAA

Covers the basic, glass cutting, forming, fusing and slumping techniques. Participants will have the opportunity to design jewellery and make fine art glass pieces.

Introduction to Drawing 5 wks. | €80

Wednesdays 21st Sep. to 19th Oct. 2016 Fee code - EDRWA

Tuition will focus on drawing from observation and will include the fundamentals of line, tone, shape, form and perspective.

QQI Certificate Courses

Irish for Pre-School Services, QQI L.5, 5N2005 10 wks. | €430

Wed. & 4 Saturdays 1st Feb. to 26th Apr. 2017 Fee code - EIP5S

Designed for those working in a Naíonraí. Participants must have a command of the Irish language and will be subject to interview at enrolment. The minimum required standard for entry to this course is the Irish in Everyday Use, QQI Level 4, 4N1179 course listed on previous page.

Hobby/Leisure Courses

Pottery 10 wks. | €160

Wednesdays 1st Feb. to 26th Apr. 2017 Fee code - EPOTS

Covers the basic methods/techniques in pottery including, pinch pots, coil pots, slab building, mould making, pot throwing, 3D ceramic & relief sculpture and glazing. Participants will have the opportunity to make pottery with both functional and decorative applications.

Introduction to Glass Fusing/ Slumping 4 wks. | €70

Wednesdays 15 Mar. to 5th Apr. 2017 Fee code - EGLSS

An introduction to glass fusing and slumping theory and techniques. Participants will have an opportunity to work with materials & equipment and prepare a range of simple glass craft pieces.

Introduction to Pottery 4 wks. | €70

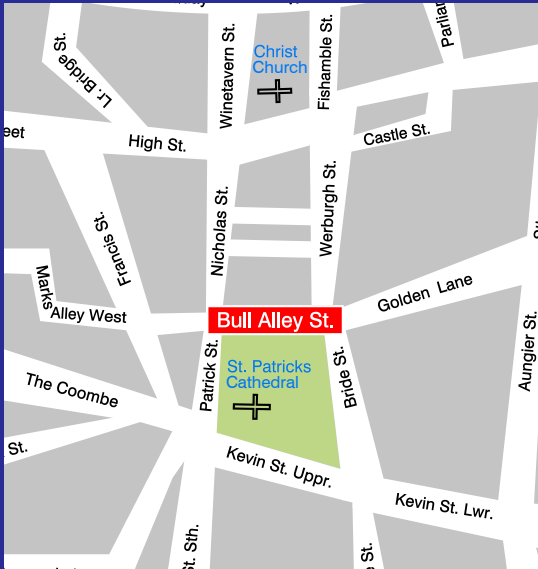
Wednesdays 3rd May to 24th May 2017 Fee code - EPTSS

An introduction to pottery including, pinch pots, coil pots, slab building. Participants will have an opportunity to learn clay techniques, to make a variety of decorative pots and ceramic pieces.

QQI is a new agency set up in 2012, replacing FETAC, HETAC, NQAI and IVQB. A candidate must accumulate eight approved minor awards/modules to attain the QQI Level 5 Major Award or certificate. These awards can be accumulated over time and are suited to part-time study.
